Day 1 (D) MELBOURNE TO MONARTO Saturday, 08 May 2027

Welcome to our 6-day tour to South Australia featuring South Australia's Nature Wonders - the newly built and opened Monarto Safari Resort and Kangaroo Island. Today we board our flight to Adelaide and begin our holiday. On arrival at Adelaide Airport, we are met by our local touring coach to take us to South Australia's newest experience - Monarto Safari Resort, the property features a modern, design-led hotel offering nature-based serenity and unique views of the safari park's native and African wildlife.

Day 2 (BD) MONARTO Sunday, 09 May 2027

Located next to the resort is Monarto Safari Park, the largest open air safari experience outside of Africa! Today we immerse ourselves in the sights, smells and sounds of the savannah as we travel across the open plains through herds of animals seemingly free to roam - safari style. With over 50 species of native and African animals, the park plays a major role, nationally and internationally, in breeding programs for rare and endangered species. After time for lunch, we're in for a real treat when we embark on The Lions 360 Experience.

It's Australia's only 360-degree lion encounter which gives you a prey's eye view into the world of these incredible predators. Walking through the tunnel, we'll emerge within clawing range of one of Australia's largest lion prides. The safe but adventurous encounter will leave us amazed. Tonight, soak in the last rays of the sun on an afterhours guided tour of the Wild Africa precinct. You'll be immersed in parklands and watch free roaming herds of animals from the comfort of the Safari Truck and savouring sunset, drinks and canapes.

Day 3 (BLD) MONARTO TO KANGAROO ISLAND Monday, 10 May

We are up early as we head to Cape Jervis. Sailing across Backstairs Passage we arrive at the unmistakable sanctity of Kangaroo Island. You are in for a treat as we spend the next three nights exploring this breathtaking island. Indulging in its towering cliffs, wild plains and pristine beaches, we discover its unique wildlife and mouth-watering produce. Firstly, uncover the secrets of Clifford's Honey Farm and taste delicious honey ice-cream, made from the unique Ligurian bee found only on Kangaroo Island. At Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery, famous for its 100% pure eucalyptus oil, enjoy lunch while discovering the makings of this fine product. We make our way to Kangaroo Island Wool where we join in an immersive working mill tour, starting with an impressive cinematic experience hosted in Australia's only 9-metre Igloo Dome, and explore the history of Kangaroo Island. From early settlers through to today's wool farmers, meet the people that have shaped Kangaroo Island's wool legacy.

After breakfast we have another beautiful day ahead of us on the island. It is time to meet some of the locals that inhabit the island at the world-famous Seal Bay Conservation Park. This seaside park is a great place to view the largest colony of Australian sea lions, watch them play on the beach, bask in the sand and swim in the sea. We now head across the island where we then find ourselves spending the afternoon exploring the Flinders Chase National Park, taking in such sights as the Remarkable Rocks, Cape du Couedic and Admirals Arch where, via a spectacular board walk, we can see close up a colony of New Zealand Fur Seals who live in the sea and the rocks just below us. What a day of truly exceptional wildlife experiences.

Day 5 (BLD) KANGAROO ISLAND Wednesday, 12 May 2027

Our first stop this morning is to Raptor Domain it's here we see a wonderful Birds of Prey demonstration in a natural setting. After the show we stay for lunch before making our way via Cygnet River to beautiful Emu Bay to visit the Lavender Farm. Their humble story began in 2001 where a small lavender garden was first planted. The farm now runs over 51 acres of land and has an estimate of 7500 lavender plants including 12 varieties.

The gift shop will be stocked with handmade products such as oils Here we will enjoy a tour followed by a delicious afternoon tea before returning to Kingscote.

Day 6 (B) KANGAROO ISLAND TO ADELAIDE Thursday, 13 May 2027

This morning, we make our way back to Penneshaw to connect with the mid-morning ferry service to Cape Jervis. Once back on the mainland, we travel through to the Adelaide Airport and relax on the flight home with memories of a great time away.
