Day 2 (BLD) SWAN HILL TO LOXTON Monday, 29 November 2027

Following breakfast we leave the area, travelling through Ouyen, where we can stretch our legs. Enjoy the serene, open roads and spend a relaxing lunch break in Pinnaroo at the Golden Grain Hotel. This afternoon we make our way to Loxton. On arrival we can settle into our accommodation as this will be home for the next three nights.

Day 3 (BLD) LOXTON LIGHTS Tuesday, 30 November 2027

Loxton on the Murray was first settled by people of (predominantly) German origin, who were escaping religious persecution. Much of the town's fascinating history is on display at the Loxton Historical Village. The town was not settled until Cobdogla Station was established in the 1850's. A William Loxton was a stockman on the Station who lived, with his wife Mary, in a slab hut on the riverbank.

We then travel to Barmera which is a popular holiday resort town situated on the shores of Lake Bonney. This morning we will see the monument dedicated to Sir Donald Campbell who attempted to break the Australian water speed record on Lake Bonney in the 1960's. From here we make our way to the Riverland Wine Centre to enjoy a tasting, talk and exploring the vibrant wine industry of the Riverland and a relaxing lunch. Tonight, as we celebrate the Christmas spirit with locals and visitors alike at the Loxton Christmas Lights. The town creates a magical world of colour and lights with wonderful street decorations, a Christmas Wonderland, Santa's Workshop and an enormous dazzling Christmas tree in the heart of the town.

Day 4 (BLD) HISTORIC RIVERLAND Wednesday, 01 December 2027

Today we head to Renmark for a visit to Olivewood Homestead, a homestead and museum containing relics from 1887 and traces of the story of the Chaffey Brothers who were instrumental in introducing irrigation to the area. It also has a heritage listed olive plantation, sweeping lawns and stunning garden beds with

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old fashioned roses. Lunch today is at Wilkadene Woolshed Brewery. Located on the banks of the River Murray, Wilkadene was a famous sheep and wheat station that supplied paddle steamers with chaff from the Woolshed down the cliff to the river. The early settlers in this area were dependent on the paddle steamers for everything from food and household goods to their religious requirements. Then we visit Angoves Wines for a wine tasting and history talk.

Day 5 (BLD) LOXTON TO HORSHAM Thursday, 02 December 2027

This morning we head to Pinnaroo along the Ngarkat Highway, noted for its wildlife and vast Mallee landscape. We continue to Bordertown, where we'll enjoy lunch at the Morning Loaf Bakery. Over the border, we pass through Kaniva to Nhill, where we visit the Aviation Heritage Centre that was established to capture Nhill's proud aviation history, spanning more than 100 years. It's a tribute to more than 10,000 young men and women who trained at the Nhill RAAF Base during World War II. The last leg of today's journey takes us to Horsham.

Day 6 (BL) HORSHAM TO HOME Friday, December 2027

This morning we visit Sylvania Park Mohair Farm - a 500-acre commercial property on the Wimmera River, home to Mulgowrie Mohair Goat Stud. We will be shown some of the farm activities including a goat shearing demonstration. We then travel to Ararat to have our farewell lunch at the Ararat RSL Club before we head back home from a fantastic tour with many fond memories and newfound friends made along the way.
